WORSHIP

___ **Flower Committee.** Assist with scheduling flowers for the service and seasonal decorating

___ **Ordinances.** Help behind the scenes with communion and baptisms

___ **Ushers.** Greet guests, hand out bulletins and take up offering on Sunday mornings

MISSIONS

___ Plan and organize mission opportunities and service projects

MINISTRY

___ **First Impressions.** Enlist greeters for services, maintain the appearance of certain areas of the church

___ **Decorating.** Interior decoration of the church to make it inviting to both visitors and church members

FELLOWSHIP

___ **Food Services.** Oversee the maintenance needs for the kitchen and equipment and plan and prepare food for events

___ **Hospitality.** Plan and carry out receptions for special church-wide events

___ **Recreation.** Plan and coordinate recreational activities to promote fellowship within the church

DISCIPLESHIP

___ **Children's Ministry.** Provide programs to nurture and minister to all children who come into the care of HBC

___ **College Committee.** Provide for regular community, discipleship and enrichment activities for college students

___ **Nursery.** Coordinate activities, programs and care for children in the nursery

ADMINISTRATIVE

___ **Exterior Premises.** Outside building maintenance and upkeep of the grounds

___ **Interior Premises.** Inside building maintenance and all facets of keeping the facility in good repair

___ **Tellers.** Collect, count and deposit the weekly offering; collect and tabulate ballots at business meetings

___ **Transportation.** Provide for the transportation needs of the church along with upkeep and maintenance of vehicles

___ **Weekday Preschool.** Serve as a liaison between the preschool and the church

OTHER

___ **Office Volunteer.** Answer phones and assist with small projects

___ **Visitation.** Visit and/or make contact with members who are in hospitals, living in retirement communities or homebound
