#### THE STORY AND THE SONG

Paraphrase from Psalm 19, Hebrews 1 and Genesis 1 in *The Jesus Storybook Bible*, lyrics from *For the Beauty of the Earth* and *All Things Bright and Beautiful* 

Leader - The Heavens are singing about how great God is; and the skies are shouting it out,

#### ALL - "See what God has made!"

Leader - Day after day... Night after night... They are speaking to us. In the beginning, there was nothing. Nothing to hear. Nothing to feel.

### **ALL** - Nothing to see.

*Leader* - Only emptiness. And darkness. And... nothing but nothing... *except*...

#### ALL - ... God was there. And God had a wonderful Plan.

Leader - "I'll take this emptiness..." God said, "and I'll fill it up! Out of the darkness, I'm going to make light! And out of the nothing, I'm going to make...

#### **ALL - EVERYTHING!"**

Leader - God spoke. That's all. And whatever God said, it happened. God wrote, "I love you!" He wrote it in the sky, and on the earth, and under the sea.

### ALL - He wrote his message everywhere!

Leader - Because God created everything in His world to reflect him like a mirror, to show us what He is like, to help us know Him, to make our hearts sing. And God saw that it was good. And still today,

### ALL - It is good!

Leader - And still, God invites us into this gift he created. He invites us to see... the skies, the mountains, the oceans... the butterflies, the birds, and the slow, purposeful sloth... the amphibian, the lamb, and the cow by the road...

# ALL - The flowers, the honeybees, the lightning bugs and all living things.

Leader - And God calls you and me to care for the beauty of the earth... For the glory of the skies, for the love which from our birth over and around us lies. God calls you and me to see... the wonder of each hour, of the day and of the night, hill and vale and tree and flower,

## ALL - Sun and moon and stars of light,

Leader - All things bright and beautiful, all things great and small,

# ALL - All things wise and wonderful; Our God made them all.

Leader - He gave us eyes to see them, and lips that we might tell

## ALL - How good is God our Father

Leader - He who doeth all things well. We gather to celebrate God's masterpiece. We gather to be with the One who has given so much. We gather to give ourselves to our Creator in our small acts of worship. And even as we leave this place today, we continue to worship God as we bear witness to and care for all that he created.

#### ALL - And God saw that it was good!!
